Length of the abstract: between 1,500 and 2,000 characters (including spaces) with an indicative bibliography. Submission of the article

If the abstract is accepted, the article will be between 20,000 and 45,000 characters long (including spaces) with the bibliography. It should be sent before 30 September 2022 to eric.monnin@univ-fcomte.fr Return of the evaluations of the article by the scientific committee: October 2022
